Location: St. Francis Xavier High School, Chapel

Size: 10 feet by 20 feet

Description: St. Francis Xavier is known as the Patron Saint of Navigators; therefore, an interpretation of a world map was the vehicle representing his world vision. Extraordinary colour choices create conversations around climate change and how the world has changed. No borders are evident, and the 'map' is unique, full of life, colour, textures and imagination. Fifty birds are interspersed throughout the composition representing the fiftieth anniversary of the school. Multiple layers of vitrified stains and enamels were applied to plate glass, fired in the kiln and crafted within a grid of zinc came.
