



Title: You Are Here 2005.

Location: Alberta Foundation for the Arts

Size: 6 feet by 9 feet

Description: This project involved the design of a glass mural that would embody a contemporary landscape narrative associated with Alberta and its Centennial. The concept incorporates the idea of encountering a crossroads literally and figuratively and the idea of maps noting that “you are here”. The ladder symbolizes the way in, out or upward. Dynamic painted brush strokes combined with deep vibrant colour contribute to the modern interpretation and curious lines and marks of the landscape. The work is made up of multiple layers of stains and enamels fired to permanence in the kiln. An innovative technique of graphite drawing on etched glass was incorporated to offer inventive and playful marks. The mural is made up of six panels secured to plate glass and house in a steel frame that acts as a divider between the lobby and the waiting area.
